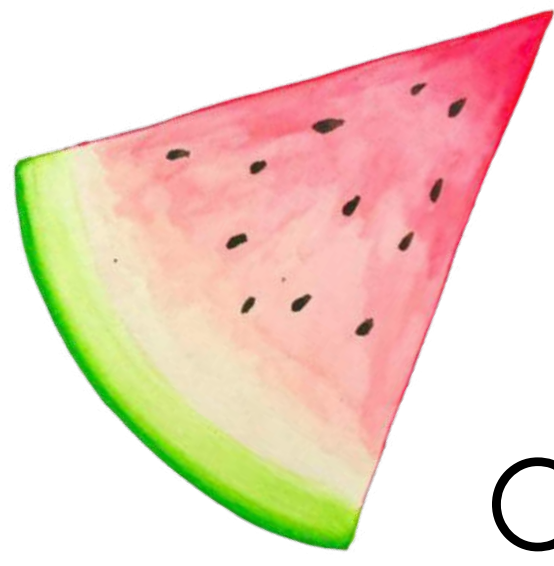

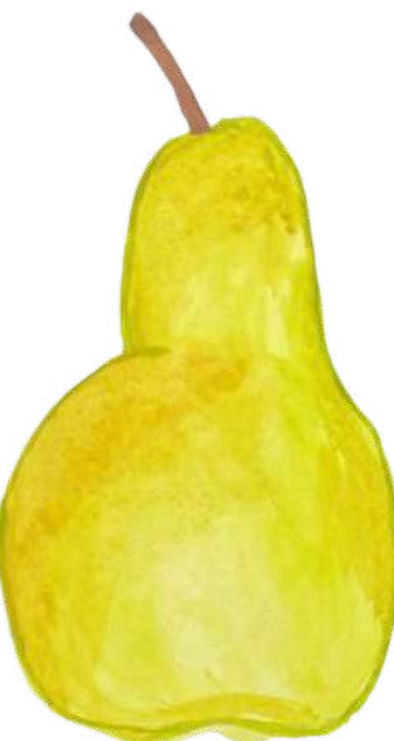
About Us



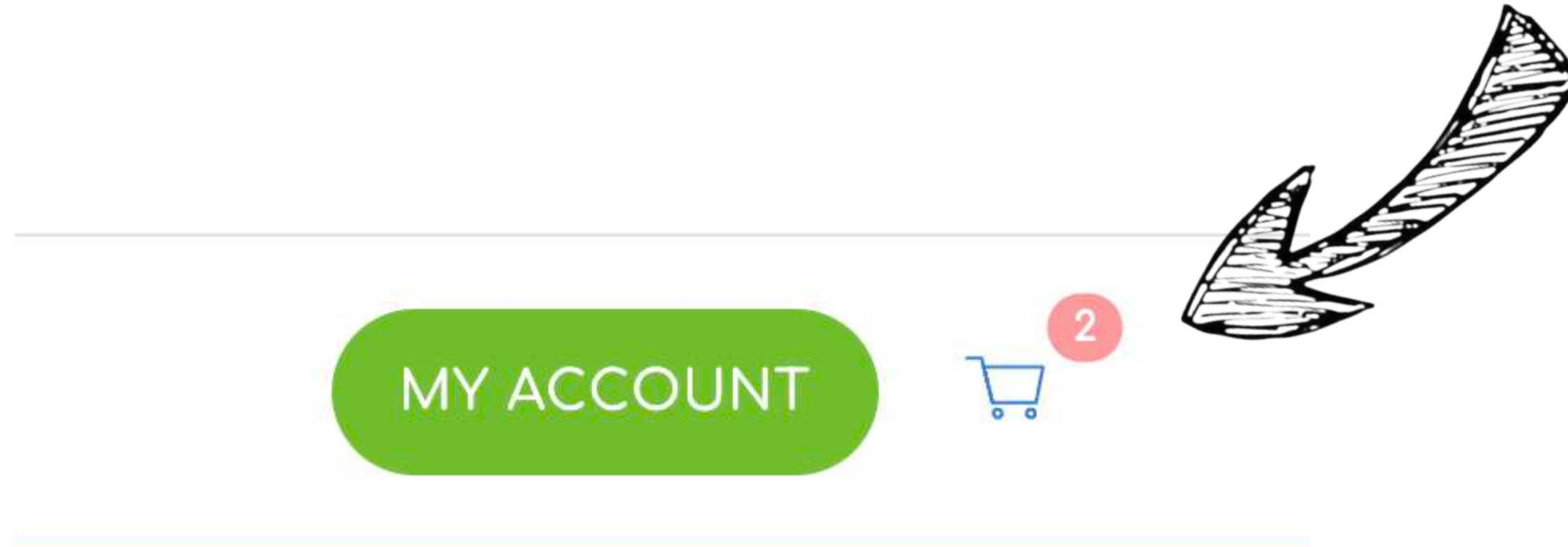

The Details & FAQs

How will my child receive their food in the reusable containers? For your convenience, images of the plating in our containers and sizing have been included to you can see exactly how your child's food will arrive.

Are the containers labeled? Each meal container is labeled with your child's name, school, group, meal and allergies (if specified). All additional snacks, drinks, etc are also labeled.

What if my child doesn't eat all their food, can they bring home their containers? Our containers are collected at the end of each lunchtime, but we do provide to-go containers for kids who would like to take home their unfinished meal.

What are the containers made of and how "sustainable" are they? Deliver Zero containers are made of sturdy 100% bpa free plastic and can sustain up to 1,500 washes per container. In one year alone, Children's Menu is saving 2.2 million packages out of landfills and trash cans by utilizing this program.

Why make this packaging shift at all? Why go through the trouble? We believe that we have a unique position as a company in the food service industry to effect change and move the needle on sustainability in a real way. Not only is the volume of packages we are saving impressive (2.5 million in one year) but as we serve children, the MOST important aspect is exposing this young generation to a daily reusable practice. We know this is new and we know this is different. But we are committed to this new way of packaging and appreciate the tremendous support of parents and schools alike as we embark on this new path.

Is there any benefit to ordering in advance? YES! Parents that place an order for the entire month in advance get 10% off with code MONTH10.

Do I need to commit to a certain amount of days? Ordering is a la carte! Parents do not need to commit to a certain amount of days in the week or month.

How late can I place my order? Order cut off time is 11pm the night before. Some day orders are available for a \$2 fee and must be submitted before 7am via email.

How does delivery work? Our trusty drivers deliver your child's meals warm directly to your school in time for lunch!

What if my child has a special allergy? We take allergies very seriously and maintain a completely nut free kitchen. In addition, we can accommodate dietary restrictions such as dairy and gluten free. If your child has further needs, our staff is available to chat and determine if the program is a fit for your child.

What if I need to cancel?: Cancellations are accepted until 7am day off and will receive a credit towards a future order. Please send your request via email to hello@childrensmenu.com

My school has set certain dietary restrictions. How do I know what to order?: We have the same menu available for all our schools. It is the responsibility of the parent to order per their school's dietary policies.

What if I want to show the staff a little extra appreciation? Can I add gratuity to my order? It takes a lot to make our little business tick and we not only depend on the hard work of our staff, but also their passion and dedication to the Children's Menu mission. Your gratuity goes a long way in showing them your appreciation for what they do. We appreciate you considering at least a 15% gratuity per order, which can be added at check out.

What is "Backpack Mail"?: Once a month, your child will be sent home with our monthly flyer (aka "Backpack Mail"). This newsletter will include our specials calendar for the upcoming month and all the fun stuff happening in the kitchen and beyond.
